A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. The invocation was delivered by Pastor Doug VanderMolen.

15-97 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the June 16, 2015 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt the minutes of the June 23, 2015 City Council work session. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

15-98 Consent Agenda

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) Zoning Board of Appeals Minutes – May 27, 2015; and b) Request for Proposals – Classification/Compensation Study. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

15-99 Adoption of Ordinance: Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance - Kennels

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to amend the C-2 General Retail provisions of the Zoning Ordinance to add “kennels, but only in a building approved for use as an animal hospital”, as a permitted special use. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

15-100 Adoption of Ordinance: Zone Change – Sherry Vanderwier, 305 E. Pontaluna Road

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to change the zoning on the property at 305 E. Pontaluna Road from SUD Special Use Development to REC Recreation. The motion was supported by Council Member Ostrom and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

15-101 Traffic Control Order – Sternberg Road

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution approving Traffic Control Orders for designation of a speed limit on Sternberg Road of 45 mph from Grand Haven Road to Martin Road as well as related adjustments to the No Passing zones. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

15-102 Water & Sewer Fees and Charges

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt a resolution to revise the Water & Sewer Fees and Charges and Rules and Regulations to remove the requirement of a service pit when using non-copper materials. The motion was supported by Council Member Ostrom and carried unanimously.

15-103 Letter of Understanding – Fire Inspector and Ordinance Enforcement Officer


Council Member Beecham moved to adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Letter of Understanding between the City and IAFF Local 2559 to add the positions of Fire Inspector and Ordinance Enforcement Officer to the union contract effective July 1, 2015. The motion was supported by Council Member Dolack and carried unanimously.

Comments

Laura Fitzpatrick, representing the Coalition for a Drug Free Muskegon County, expressed her appreciation for the City's participation in the Coalition and for the Police and Fire Department involvement in the Muskegon Alcohol Liability Initiative. The programs have received national attention and the Medication Disposal Program will be included in a national prevention strategy.

City Administrator Mark Meyers reported that the wayfinding signs were installed today.
