CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
October 21, 2014

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. The invocation was delivered by Reverend Andy Husmann.

14-157 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the October 7, 2014 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

14-158 Consent Agenda

Council Member Martines moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) September 2014 Monthly Reports; and b) Minutes of the September 9, 2014 Planning Commission meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

14-159 Public Hearing – Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate – Intelligent Machine Solutions, Inc., 1269 E. Mt. Garfield Road

The City Clerk certified the publishing and mailing of the notice of public hearing.

A public hearing was held. No one commented on the application.

Council Member Martines moved to adopt a resolution granting an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate to Intelligent Machine Solutions, Inc. for personal property located at 1269 E. Mt. Garfield Road for a period of 12 years. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

14-160 Public Hearing – Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate – Philos Foods, 6366 Norton Center Drive

The City Clerk certified the publishing and mailing of the notice of public hearing.

A public hearing was held. No one commented on the application.

Council Member Ostrom moved to adopt a resolution granting an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate to Philos Foods, LLC for personal property located at 6366 Norton Center Drive for a period of 12 years. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

14-161 MPTC (Non-Union) Pay Plan Amendment – Police Chief Pension Plan

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution authorizing the following fringe benefit changes for certain Management, Professional, Technical and Clerical (MPTC) employees effective December 1, 2014: 1) MERS division 22 (Police Chief and Lieutenants-50/25) is closed; 2) The police chief position is transferred to MERS division 10 (MPTC-55/15); and 3) All members in division 22 are transferred to division 10 (MPTC). The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

14-162 Automobile Dealer License – Daniel Cooper, 2935 Fairfield Street

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution granting an automobile dealer license to Daniel Cooper for the property at 2935 Fairfield Street. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

14-163 Sewer Determination Appeal – Nuvo College of Cosmetology, 907 W. Norton Avenue

Council Member Martines moved to postpone this matter. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

Public Comment – General

Mr. Dan Olson of 1492 Bayview Drive urged the City Council not to go with a single trash hauler City-wide. He commented that the concept strips away any competition because it will be too costly for smaller companies to bid on a contract. He also expressed concern about the potential closing of the Wood Road leaf site. Mr. Jeremy Schipma, resident of 1900 Hendrick Road and owner of Lake Effect Disposal, echoed Mr. Olson's comments.

Circuit Court Kathy Hoogstra introduced herself as a candidate for Judge of the 14<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court.

Mr. Ed Garner of Muskegon Area First assured the Council that MAF is working very closely with businesses, including Intelligent Machine, Philos Foods and American Glass Mosaics. MAF also tries to assist with the marketing of the K-Mart property.

Council Member Bill Moulatsiotis recognized his father-in-law, Don Underwood, who recently passed away. Mr. Underwood was a well-respected man who was very active in service to our country.
