Class A type crimes (more serious) were down by 29% for the month and up by 1% for the fiscal year compared to last year. Class B type crimes were down by 28% for the month, and down by 8% for the fiscal year total. Total crimes were down by 29% for the month and down by 3% for the fiscal year to date.

PATROL

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The patrol division responded to an armed robbery that occurred at the 800 block of East Broadway Avenue. The suspect entered the store wearing a ski mask and pulled out a gun and demanded money. The employee gave the suspect over \$500.00. The employee gave a description of the suspect and the vehicle the suspect had left in. The officers checked the area and later found the vehicle in the 2700 block of Valk. The suspect was apprehended and a search warrant was obtained to search the suspect's residence. The officers located the gun that was used, ski mask and other evidence. The suspect was charged and lodged for armed robbery. No one was hurt and the money was located.

The patrol division responded to a possible breaking and entering at a business located at the 2400 block of West Sherman. Officers arrived and found two subjects near the entry way of the business. The business was closed at the time of the call. The officers approached the suspects and they took off running. The officers pursued the suspects and eventually apprehended them. The officers found the building to be secure but charged the two suspects for attempted breaking and entering. The suspects were lodged at the Muskegon County Jail on those charges.


The patrol division responded to Mona Shores High School on a report of a construction trailer/office being broken into over the weekend and electronics stolen. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with an employee. The officers observed pry marks on the door where the suspect had entered. The items stolen were electronic equipment and

computers. The scene was processed by the officers as they dusted for prints and took pictures. A suspect has been identified and the officers are currently following up on the case. The case still remains active until the suspect is located.

Patrol division was dispatched to the 400 block of Lakeshore on a report of a felonious assault in progress. Officers responded to an assault where a man had a knife and was threatening another person with it. The victim called and reported that her husband was intoxicated and had held two knives to the victim's throat and then grabbed a BB gun and pointed it at her. The officers arrived and located the victim. The victim was removed safely from the scene and then the officers located the suspect. The suspect was found to be in possession of the gun and knife. The officers were able to get the BB gun and knife away from the suspect without any problems or anyone getting hurt. The suspect was charged and lodged at the Muskegon County Jail for felonious assault.

Total cruiser mileage for the month of June was 27,478 miles.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of June 2016, the Department recorded 1666 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1310 calls for service. A total of 822 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Wednesday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 37 parking tickets and 203 traffic citations in June, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 56.5% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

TRAINING

In the month of June, 26 officers, which include 9 command officers, were trained in Physical Control tactics. This is to aid officers with physical confrontations and determine how to better handle a situation. Training goals are to help the officers to understand the winning mindset, pre-assault indicators, liability/current case law, report writing and to properly demonstrate the three stance positions, controls holds, take-downs, strikes, kicks, blocks, weapon retention and disarming, pressure points, and handcuffing tactics.

One officer went to Forensics Pathology training in Grand Rapids. This training helped with effective investigation of events involving injury or death that requires recognition of patterns of physical findings on the body and at the scene. This type of training would help to properly assess the scene and begin proper procedure for collection of relevant evidence.

Two officers attended underwater dive training in Grand Rapids where they were able to continue their certification and training to be better prepared when needed in a dive rescue situation.

One office clerk attended training in Wyoming, Michigan named Understanding State and Federal Firearms qualifications. This class was to assist in understanding who is eligible and who is not eligible for registering a firearm in the State of Michigan.

INVESTIGATIONS

During the month of June the detective bureau was assigned six new cases. Four cases were cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The detective bureau investigated arson in the 1500 block of Norwich. The owner of the home set the house on fire after becoming angry with her adult children. The owner confessed to the fire and was lodged at the Muskegon County Jail.

The detective bureau investigated three separate criminal sexual assault reports involving children. All three cases were closed after a forensic interview with the children did not disclose an assault.

Detective Neher attended training on Forensic Pathology for Investigators. The training taught investigators about the early recognition of certain patterns of injury on the human body so investigators properly assess the scene and begin proper procedure for collection of relevant evidence.

The detective bureau signed a total of 47 warrants and two search warrants this month which included warrants from the patrol division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET assisted a buy/bust investigation where the suspect was caught with approximately 60 grams of cocaine. The suspect is awaiting trial.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in a search warrant where approximately 18 grams of suspected meth was located in the house. Six grams of marijuana and small amounts of heroin and cocaine were also located. Three suspects have been charged in this case.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in one search warrant in the month of June and seized over 60 grams of cocaine, 6 grams of marijuana and 18 grams of crystal meth.

INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN (ICAC):

The Detective from ICAC assisted downloading several devices for the City of Muskegon Police Department's recent homicide investigations.
