CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
May 19, 2015

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, May 19, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. The invocation was delivered by Pastor Doug VanderMolen.

15-72 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the May 4, 2015 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

15-73 Consent Agenda

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) April 2015 Monthly Reports; b) Minutes of the April 14, 2015 Planning Commission meeting; c) Resolution: 2015 Property Tax Levy; d) Request for Proposals – Engineering Services – Mona Kai Water Main Replacement; e) Request for Proposals – Engineering Services – 2016 Sidewalk Construction; f) Request for Proposals – Engineering Services – Henry Street Bridge Repair; and g) Bid Authorization – Microfilm Conversion. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

15-74 Adoption of Ordinance: Amendment to the Code of Ordinances – Second Hand Dealers

Council Member Martines moved to adopt an amendment to the Code of Ordinances with regard to reporting requirements for second hand dealers. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

15-75 Special Use Permit – Staci Walters, 931 Ashlee Court

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution granting a special use permit to Staci Walters for a special use permit for day care usage in an R-3 Single Family Residential district for the property at 931 Ashlee Court. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

15-76 Land Division – Ken Brondyke, 6384 Martin Road

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt a resolution granting permission for Ken Brondyke to divide the property at 6384 Martin Road in accordance with the submitted plan. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

15-77 Certificate of Delinquent Charges to 2015 City Tax Roll

Council Member Ostrom moved to adopt a resolution certifying delinquent special assessments, water and sewer bills and ordinance violations to the 2014 City Tax Roll. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

15-78 Bid Award – 2015 Street Reconstruction and Water Main Replacement

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt a resolution awarding the bid for construction services for the 2015 street reconstruction and water main replacement project to the low bidder, Hallack Contracting of Hart, Michigan, in the amount of \$1,068,690.94. The motion was supported by Council Member Hylland and carried unanimously.

15-79 Bid Award – 2015 Sidewalk Construction

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution awarding the bid for construction services for the 2015 sidewalk construction project to the sole bidder, Kamminga & Roodvoets of Grand Rapids, Michigan, in the amount of \$453,237.50. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

15-80 Closed Session to Discuss Collective Bargaining

Council Member Beecham moved to adjourn to closed session to discuss collective bargaining. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried 8-1 on a roll call vote with Council Member Moulatsiotis voting “no”.

Council adjourned to closed session at 5:48 p.m.

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to return to open session. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

Council returned to open session at 6:05 p.m.
