CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 2, 2015

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, June 2, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. The invocation was delivered by Council Member Martines.

15-81 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the May 19, 2015 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

15-82 Consent Agenda

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of the April 22, 2015 Zoning Board of Appeals meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

15-83 Resolution of Intent – National Flood Insurance Program

Council Member Martines moved to adopt a resolution of intent to participation the National Flood Insurance Program. The motion was supported by Council Member Dolack and carried unanimously.

15-84 Introduction of Ordinance: Amendment to the Personnel Ordinance

Council Member Beecham moved to introduce an amendment to the Personnel Ordinance to clarify employees' eligibility for receiving post-retirement benefits other than pension. The motion was supported by Council Member Dolack and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

15-85 Special Use Permit – Verizon Wireless, 455 Ellis Road

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt a resolution granting a special use permit to Wireless for wireless communications tower usage in a PUD Planned Unit Development district for the property at 455 Ellis Road. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

15-86 Bid Award – Fire Hydrant Painting

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution granting awarding the bid for fire hydrant painting to D & S Painting of Norton Shores in the amount of \$40,250. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

Kimberly Fisher of 1830 Bundt Drive presented concerns about a project in her neighborhood and the use of Bundt Drive for construction vehicles. City Administrator Mark Meyers said City staff will look into Ms. Fisher's concerns and provide a response.
