CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 21, 2016

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, June 21, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. A moment of silence was observed in memory of Council Member Gary Ostrom.

16-101 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the June 7, 2016 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

16-102 Consent Agenda

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) May 2016 Monthly Reports; b) minutes of the May 10, 2016 Planning Commission meeting; and c) Resolution: Extend Ross Park Hours. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

16-103 FY-2017 MPTC Pay Plan

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt a resolution establishing the FY-2017 MPTC Pay Plan. The motion was supported by Council Member Dolack and carried unanimously.

Ms. Jenny McNeill introduced herself as a candidate for Muskegon County Probate Court Judge.

Mr. Geoffrey Nolan introduced himself as a candidate for Muskegon County District Court Judge.

Council Member Dolack stated the City of Muskegon is offering curbside pickup of brush after last week's storm and wondered if Norton Shores could do the same. Public Works Director Jerry Bartoszek reported DPW personnel has been removing brush from the right-of-way and opened the Wood Road leaf site on week days temporarily. He also noted that Muskegon does not have a site available to residents for disposal of brush.

Council Member Hylland asked who designed the new traffic pattern on Pontaluna Road at US-31 and stated some aspects of the improvement are a bit difficult. Mr. Bartoszek reported that it is an MDOT design. Council Member Beecham noted that it is a definite improvement.

City Administrator Mark Meyers thanked City staff and Consumers Energy for their response to the recent storm. He also commended Mr. Bartoszek and City Engineering Jim Murphy for the Airline Road reconstruction recently completed.

Mr. Meyers invited Council to a meeting regarding the Seminole Road Place Plan to be held in the Community Room on Thursday, June 30 at 5:30 p.m.
