

CITY OF NORTON SHORES
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
August 1, 2016

A rescheduled meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Monday, August 1, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. The invocation was delivered by Pastor Doug VanderMolen.

16-115 Comment on Agenda Items

Christine Smith of 5129 Martin Road, Cheryl Policka of 5145 Martin Road, and Peter Waltz of 39 Porter Road thanked the Council for considering the ordinance to allow the raising of chickens in residential areas but suggested that the requirements for housing the chickens should be less restrictive.

16-116 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the July 19, 2016 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt the minutes of the July 26, 2016 City Council work session. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

16-117 Introduction of New Firefighter

Fire Chief Bob Gagnon introduced the City's most recently promoted firefighter, Adam Langlois. Firefighter Langlois' father presented him with his badge.

16-118 Consent Agenda

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of the minutes of the April 27, 2016 Zoning Board of Appeals meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

16-119 Adoption of Ordinance – Zone Change – Lorraine McCombs Wright, 1032 Airport Road

Council Member Martines moved to adopt an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to change the zoning on the property at 1032 Airport Road from C-2 General Retail to R-2 Single Family Residential. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

16-126 Bid Award – 2016 City Streets Project

Council Member Martines moved to adopt a resolution awarding the bid for roadway reconstruction and water main replacement of Norton Hills Road between Norcrest Drive and Applewood Lane and Hendrick Road and Stanwood Street between Henry Street and Churchill Drive to the low bidder, Kamminga & Roodvoets, Inc. in the amount of \$1,370,151.65. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

16-127 Bid Award – Norton Cemetery Fence

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution awarding the bid for replacement of the perimeter fence at Norton Cemetery to the low bidder, Affordable Door & Gate of Muskegon in the total amount of \$26,045.88. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

16-128 Memorandum of Agreement – Little River Band of Ottawa Indians – Harvey Street Improvements

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Memorandum of Agreement on behalf of the City and authorize the additional work for the reconstruction of Harvey Street between Ellis Road and Hile Road in the amount of \$48,927 for additional engineering to Prein & Newhof, as well as the additional cost of construction up to \$365,868. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.


Michael Poulin of North Muskegon introduced himself as a candidate for Muskegon County Sheriff.
