CITY COUNCIL MEETING
September 16, 2014

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, September 16, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. The invocation was delivered by Reverend Andy Husmann.

14-143 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the September 2, 2014 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

14-144 Consent Agenda

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) August 2014 Monthly Reports; b) Minutes of the August 12, 2014 Planning Commission meeting; and c) Resolution scheduling a public hearing date of October 7, 2014 to consider an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate application from J & M Machine Products, Inc., 1821 Manor Drive. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

14-145 Public Hearing – Community Development Block Grant 3rd Program Year Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (C.A.P.E.R.)

The City Clerk certified the publishing of the notice of public hearing.

A public hearing was held. No one commented on the report.

Council Member Martines moved to adopt a resolution authorizing submission of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Year 2013 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

14-146 Public Hearing – Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate – Lakeside Surfaces, Inc., 6274 Norton Center Drive

The City Clerk certified the publishing and mailing of the notice of public hearing.

A public hearing was held. No one commented on the application.

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt a resolution granting an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate to Lakeside Surfaces, Inc. for real and personal property located at 6274 Norton Center Drive for a period of 12 years. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

14-147 Introduction of Ordinance: Zone Change – Muskegon Elks Lodge #274, 513 W. Pontaluna Road

Council Member Beecham moved to introduce an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to change the zoning on the property at 513 W. Pontaluna Road from REC Recreation to PUD Planned Unit Development. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

14-148 MPTC Pay Plan Amendment

Council Member Ostrom moved to adopt a resolution amending the MPTC (non-union employees) Pay Plan to increase the maximum amount of compensation for employees opting out of the City's group health plan and adding hearing care benefits to the health plan effective October 1, 2014. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

Public Comment – General

Mr. Jeremy Anderson of 3990 Loomis expressed concern about safety when walking or cycling to Ross Park from the Roodmont area and requested that the City pursue funding for a sidewalk from that area to Ross Park Elementary School.

City Administrator Mark Meyers reminded Council of the Unity Prayer Breakfast to be held on Saturday, September 20, 2014.
