CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
December 16, 2014

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, December 16, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. The invocation was delivered by Reverend Andy Husmann.

14-182 Minutes

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt the minutes of the December 2, 2014 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

14-183 Consent Agenda

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) November 2014 Monthly Reports; b) Minutes of the November 18, 2014 Special Planning Commission Meeting; c) Bid Authorization – Articulated Tractor; d) Request for Proposals – Engineering and Construction Oversight – Airline Road Reconstruction; e) Resolution of Support: Spring Lake Township Grant Application – Black Lake Park Plan; and f) Resolution: CDBG Lien Release – 2956 Continental Street. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

14-184 Bid Award – Engineering Services – 2015 Road Reconstruction Projects

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution awarding the contract for engineering design and construction oversight services for the 2015 City Street Reconstruction project to the low bidder, Prein & Newhof of Grand Rapids, Michigan, for the not to exceed amount of \$65,400. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

14-185 Bid Award – Engineering Services - Estes Street Water Main Replacement

Council Member Dolack moved to adopt a resolution awarding the bid for engineering design and construction services for the Estes Street Water Main Replacement project to the low bidder, Prein & Newhof of Grand Rapids, Michigan for the not to exceed amount of \$35,600. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

14-186 Contract Extension – Leaf and Yard Waste Disposal

Council Member Martines moved to adopt a resolution extending the contract for leaf and yard waste disposal with Republic Services of Muskegon, Michigan for a period of one year through December 31, 2015 at a rate of \$96.45 per hour for the equipment with driver and \$6.00 per cubic yard for disposal of leaf and yard waste. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

14-187 Contract Extension – Brush, Log and Stump Grinding Services

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt a resolution extending the contract for brush, log and stump grinding services with Great Lakes Nursery Soils, Inc. of Muskegon, Michigan for a period of one year through December 31, 2015 at the same price of \$1.25 per cubic yard. The motion was supported by Council Member Martines and carried unanimously.

14-188 Bid Award – Water Meters

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to adopt a resolution awarding the bid for residential water meters to the low bidder, Etna Supply Company of Grand Rapids, Michigan in the amount of \$100,050. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

Comments

Mr. Tom George of 535 Seminole Road inquired about the status of single hauler refuse collection. Mayor Nelund explained that the proposals will be discussed at the January 27, 2015 work session.

Mr. Don Fischer of 3868 Peninsula Drive commented that mail trucks drive on the shoulder of the road contributing to deterioration.

Mr. Harold Husted of 4434 Birchwood Court asked what affect a single hauler would have on the leaf sites.

City Administrator Mark Meyers reminded Council there is no work session in December. The next regular Council meeting will be January 6, 2015.
